#### Report of ITC & ITT:

(Agnel Industrial Technical College & Agnel Institute of technical Training):

Fr. Agnel ITC which was established in the year 1961 by late Rev. Fr. C. Rodrigues is a premier institute which is offering vocational courses in the trades of Draughtsman (Mechanical), Fitter, Electrician and Mechanic (Motor Vehicle).

The institute has experienced teaching faculty well equipped workshops and successfully training around 350 students every year.

The academic year started on 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2010 with inaugural function attended by Rev. Fr. Diniz, Mr. Debnath, Fr. Victor Rebello, Mr. Narendra Joshi, Principal.

This year ITC results was 96% four student's appeared for state level skill competition held at Mumbai I.T.I. in their respective trades. Our ITT (Trade Course) students did well. The final exams result was 98%. Our student had factory visit to Air India, Santacruz, BEST Workshop, Wadala, Mapco Industry at Mahableshwar and many more. We had campus interviews for firms like Godrej, Indian Airlines and Thermostat, Vasai.

Most of our students have been absorbed in reputed firms. Last year 100% of our student secured jobs. This year too, we are expecting the same.

From Last year M/s Toyota Motors are successfully training our MMV students at their workshop. They have selected 18 of our students in their firm.

This year we imparted training in our campus to the boys of Chanakya Shipping Corporation in Electrical trade. We had a grand inaugural function on 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2010 for these students, attended by Rev. Fr. F. Diniz, Rev. Fr.Victor Rebello, Mr. Debnath, Mr. Narendra Joshi, College Principal.

We are also imparting campus training to deaf & dumb students of "Save the Children-India" institute, in Electrical, Carpentry and Plumbing trades, so that these boys will stand on their own feet to earn their living. We have done value addition to the existing course syllabus of various trades. Every student will get additional knowledge in basic computer knowledge, Microsoft office softwares and internet. They will be given special training on CNC programming. **Mr. Mushtaq Malgundkar** is managing this programme successfully.

Recently we have done a Tie-up with M/S. Allied Motors, Mumbai. Our Motor Mechanic students go to their workshop for practical training on Maruti Suzuki vehicles.

# A brief annual report of Community development through Polytechnic.

Fr. Agnel Community Polytechnic has been imparting Vocational Training to drop out, unemployed, below average, underprivileged urban & rural youths by establishing Extension Centers since 1983.

During the year 2010-2011 over 1500 youths in different vocational trades at various extension centers were trained. The centers are situated at Vasind (with JSW), Shahapur (with Archana Trust), Panvel (with Ambuja Cement), Daman (with Punj Sons), Murbad (with Navjeevan Trust), in Nirmal, (Vasai Taluka), Ghansoli (Navi Mumbai), Zidake (Bhiwandi Taluka), & Mumbra (with MESCO) are being trained.

More than 15000 school dropouts from rural & semi-urban areas in 30 different trades have been trained so far by us since 1983. **Mr. Jaywant Raut** is managing this programme successfully.

Sports day and Marathon for all vocational centers was organized in Ambernath on 14 & 15<sup>TH</sup> February 2011. The Annual day will be organized on 23<sup>rd</sup> of February at Kalyan.

We are also working with ASLG for a training and consultancy assignment in Essar Steel for ITW Signode. A welding training center and CNC training center is being planned with ASLG. The Labour

welfare ministry of Maharashtra state has done tie up with us for taking technical education to nook

and corners of Maharashtra. A project for vocational training at JSW plants at Ratnagiri and Nandyal

is at the planning stage. A training course with Mahindra & Mahindra is scheduled in the coming

months.

CII 4th Global Summit on Skills Development on 29-30 November 2010, Mumbai was attended by Fr

Victor Rebello and Mr. Narendra Joshi. Fr Victor presented our model of Industry Institute tie ups for

community development at NITTR-AICTE conference in Delhi. There was thought exchange with Pan

IIT, ArKA and ARTI about technology transfer and mode of vocational training.

Today's annual day celebration "FESTEJO 2011" is being organized by the active participation of all

students' council members of Polytechnic and ITC with the able guidance from the student's council

chairmen Mr. Sunil R Anande of Polytechnic and Mr. Mushtaq Malgundkar of I.T.C.
